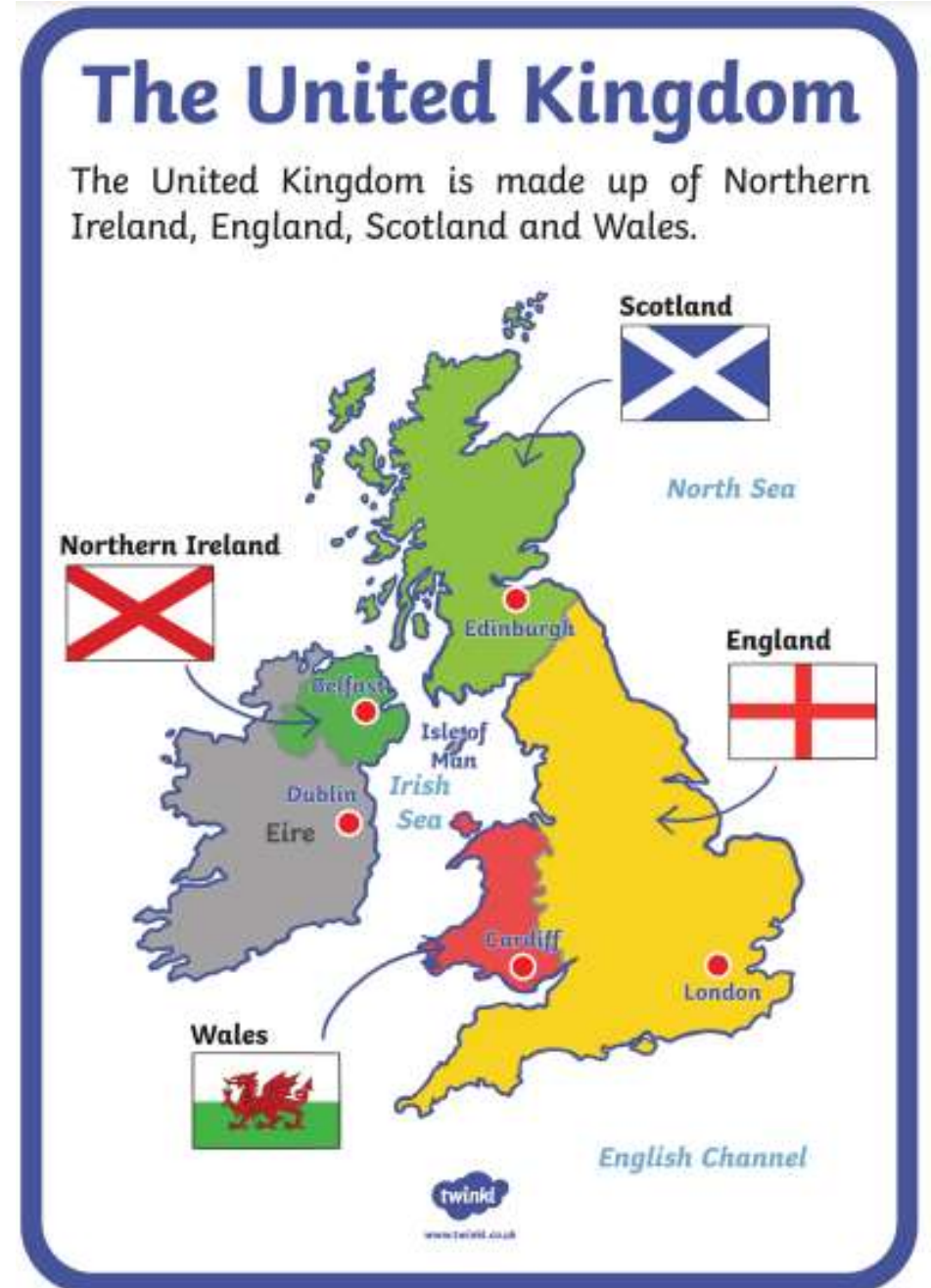







UK Knowledge Organiser

Key vocabulary	Explanation
town	A town is a place where people live and work. There may be shops, places of worship, leisure facilities and schools there. It is bigger than a village but smaller than a city.
countryside	Land that is not in towns or cities. The countryside has lots of farmland and often woodland.
Country	An area of land with its own government, rules and borders.
UK	The United Kingdom. It is made up of four countries: England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.
island	An area of land surrounded by water.
capital city	The place where the government sits.
landmark	An object from a place that is easily recognisable. This could be a human or physical feature. Big Ben is a landmark in London.
human feature	An object that was made and built by people, such as Buckingham Palace.
Physical feature	An object that occurred naturally, like The Thames
population	How many people live in one particular place. This could be the population of a city, a town, a country or the whole world.
