

Science

Children will learn about 'Animals, including humans'. They will learn about the things that animals including humans need to survive and how humans stay healthy. They will also learn about how the needs and the appearance of humans change as they grow. The children will have the opportunity to ask and answer their own enquiry questions and carry out simple investigations.

The Arts and Computing (Art, DT, Music and Computing)

In Art children will learn about hot and cold colours, shades and tints. Children will investigate how to use these to paint the background of their fire pictures. Children will use David Best's art as inspiration for adding building detail using thick and thin lines.

In Music children will listen, sing, play, compose, improvise and perform a range of songs used tuned instruments.

In Computing children will learn how search effectively and safely on the World Wide Web using a browser and search engine called 'Swiggle'. Children will use questioning to create their own binary trees. We will continue our Evolve online safety lessons.

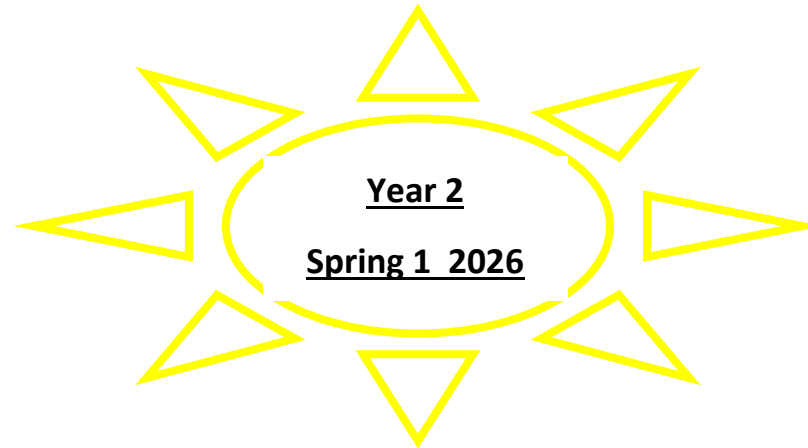
Humanities (Geography, History and RE)

Children will be learning about key facts of 'The Great Fire of London' and key people e.g. Thomas Farriner, King Charles II and Samuel Pepys. They will learn about primary and secondary sources.

In Religious Education the children will be considering the big question 'How do we understand the unseen?'

Dear Parents/Carers

Happy New Year to you and your families. Our topic for this half-term is 'The Great Fire of London.'. During this topic we will learn about fire safety today. We hope to welcome firefighters to our school. In our Art lessons children will be learning to use shades and tints to create their own Great Fire of London paintings. In PSHE children will think about new goals and put in place steps to achieve these.



PE

In long PE children will focus on their football skills including dribbling and keeping possession, passing and receiving and dribbling to score a point in a game. In short PE children will use gesture, turns travel and jumps and choreograph their own weather dance.

Children will be

- reading and listening to adventure stories.
- predicting story events.
- learning and writing adventure diaries with a focus on setting descriptions.
- reading a range of texts fluently with understanding and comprehension.
- learning about and using a range of grammar features in their writing e.g. nouns, adjectives, verbs, adverbs.
- using a range of punctuation e.g. full stops, exclamation marks, question marks, apostrophes and commas.
- reading, writing and performing poetry.

Maths

Children will learn

- how to multiply and divide. Children will learn different strategies and representations. Children will learn how to make links between times tables.
- how to solve word problems involving multiplication and division.
- how to find fractions of shape and of numbers.
