	Mangle Used to wring the water out of the clothes after they have been washed.	metal
	Wash tub A metal tub used to wash clothes and people instead of a washing machine or bath.	metal
	Washboard Used to scrub the clothes clean instead of a washing machine.	metal
	Carpet beater Used to clean the carpets and rugs in the house instead of a Hoover.	wood
	Iron Heated up on a fire and used to iron the clothes.	metal

herbivore	An animal that eats plants.
carnivore	An animal that eats other animals.
omnivore	An animal that eats a variety of both plants and animals.



Mary Anning

Mary Anning was a famous fossil hunter and collector. She found and identified many prehistoric fossils from the time of the dinosaurs and sold them to make money for her family. Mary Anning was one of the earliest fossil hunters to identify pre-historic fossils.

Dinosaur	Name of dinosaur	Facts about the dinosaur
	T Rex	A carnivore that was 12m high. It lived in swamps and forests. Even though it was big, it was very fast and ran at 16mph.
	Brachiosaurus	It was a herbivore and it got a lot of its food from trees using its long neck. It lived in forests and was 23m high.
	Stegosaurus	A herbivore that had two rows of plates along its back. It had a very small brain. It was 9m long and lived in woodlands.
	Pteranodon	It was a carnivore. Its wings were 9m wide and had a long thin beak. It didn't have any feathers. It lived by the coast and ate fish.
	Diplodocus	A herbivore with a huge long whip like tail. It used its long neck to reach the treetops. It was 25m long, which is the length of 2 buses.
	Triceratops	It was a herbivore. Its head had a frill and 3 horns which were used as weapons. It was 9m long and it lived in the forests and ate plants.
