The children will have the opportunity to feed and stroke the animals if they wish. We will be having a 'farm' themed day with lots of other farm activities going on throughout the day too. On **Tuesday 15 July** we will doing an assembly to parents so please keep the date free!!

Our topic this half term is:

ANIMALS

English and Phonics

We are continuing to help children to use their knowledge of letters in their reading and writing. They benefit greatly from practise, so thank you for your continuing support in working with your child on their reading at home. Please also continue to go through your child's green phonic book with them daily. Please sign the reading diary for each book so that we know the book has been read. The children love bringing their book home and sharing it with you!! I hope you are as impressed with their reading as we are!!!

We are encouraging your child to write as much as possible so please encourage them at home too. Perhaps they could help you write your shopping list or write about a visit they have been on or something they have done or write a card for someone. Don't forget to get them to write in lower case. In class we will be learning the story The Three Billy Goats Gruff. We will then be changing the characters to create a new story.

EYFS – Reception

Maths

In Maths this half term we will be continuing to consolidate all our number work. This will include number bonds to 10, number recognition to 20, doubles, sharing, odd and even numbers and addition and subtraction. We will also be looking closely at repeating patterns and revising positional language and using maps and following instructions. As part of our Maths work we will also be revising 2D shapes and using the shapes to create pictures and looking at them at them in different positions.

Physical Development

In PE children will be learning to play attack and defence games. The children will learn to play in a team and learn to find a space. Children will also be looking again at how to keep healthy by eating, sleeping and developing good hygiene routines. We will also be looking at different forms of exercise.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be working on a new value each month. The value in June is 'Kindness' and in July it is 'Friendship'. In PSHE we are focussing on Changes. We will talk about their move into Year 1 and support them with their transition and their feelings towards different changes. In RHE we will also be looking at routines and patterns of a typical day, understanding why hygiene is important and recognising all families are different.

Communication and Language

In Communication and Language we will be continuing to work on talking in complete sentences, using the correct tense and using describing words. We will also be learning the story The Three Billy Goats Gruff, encouraging children to use different voices for the different characters. We will also be revising writing a recount and using the words first, next, then and finally to order events.

Understanding of the World

This half term we will be looking at different animals. We will be comparing different types of animals and their habitats. Children will be comparing zoo animals and farm animals and learning the names of adult and baby animals. Children will go on a minibeast hunt and will learn about the different habitats they live in. We will also be watching a caterpillar turn into a butterfly!!! We will also be looking back on the past year and how they have changed in themselves. In RE we will learning about prayer and comparing the different religions we have learned about over the year.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will continue to develop children's artistic skills. This half term children will be using different resources and materials to create their own mini beast and observational drawing of minibeasts. They will also be constructing a bridge for the goats to travel over.
