



## Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) Outcomes 2024

**EYFS Outcomes: Children have reached a Good Level of Development at the end of EYFS if they have achieved at least the expected level in the Early Learning Goals for the prime areas of learning – personal, social and emotional, physical development and communication and language and the Early Learning Goals in the specific areas of Mathematics and Literacy.**

Our school in 2024 was 9% above the Luton LA and 3% above National. In 2023 and 2024 our EYFS GLD remained higher than Luton and National.

Our School for five consecutive year's pre Covid remained above National and Luton LA. There was no EYFS data for 2020 and 2021 due to the Covid pandemic. Since 2014 we have made huge improvements in our EYFS provision overtime. In 2023 and 2024 our EYFS outcomes were above Luton and National.

This was identified as an Ofsted priority in January 2015 and in Dec 2018. 'Outdoor learning facilities are underused for children in the early years'.

The school has rigorously made continuous improvements to our EYFS outcomes, embedded a higher quality of education, teaching and learning, enrichment activities, better outdoors provision, quality adult interactions and engagement with our pupils and purposeful, stimulating learning opportunities offered to all of our pupils which we will continue with this academic year.
