Findings from Pupil Voice discussions carried out by MPPs in class.

Common ideas and actions for promoting friendship on the playground were as follows:

Be kind to everyone. Say kind words.

Sometimes play with new friends.

Say NO to bullying.

Share playground equipment.

Be a good listener.

If children look alone or lonely check on them, ask if they are okay, ask them to play with you.

Use a friendship bench/area to indicate if you want a new friend.

Talk about disagreements or share with a grown up. Never fight.

If anyone is hurt, help them (not just friends you know). Take them to a grown up/medical room.

Look after those not feeling well.

These ideas could be shared with dinner ladies and Mrs Begum, class teachers and in a whole school assembly.
